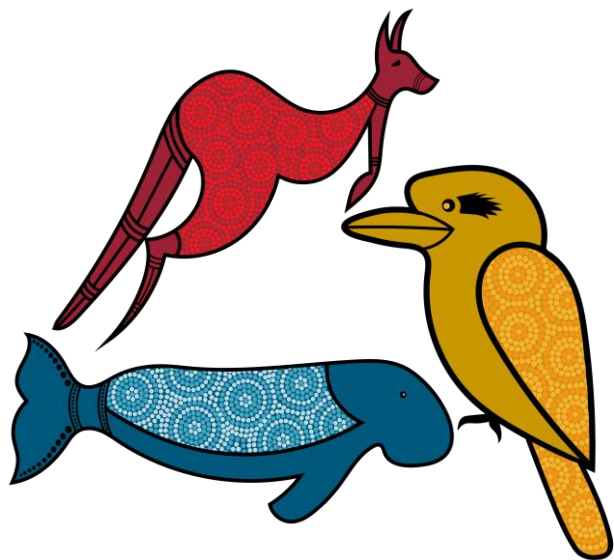
Books donations for library

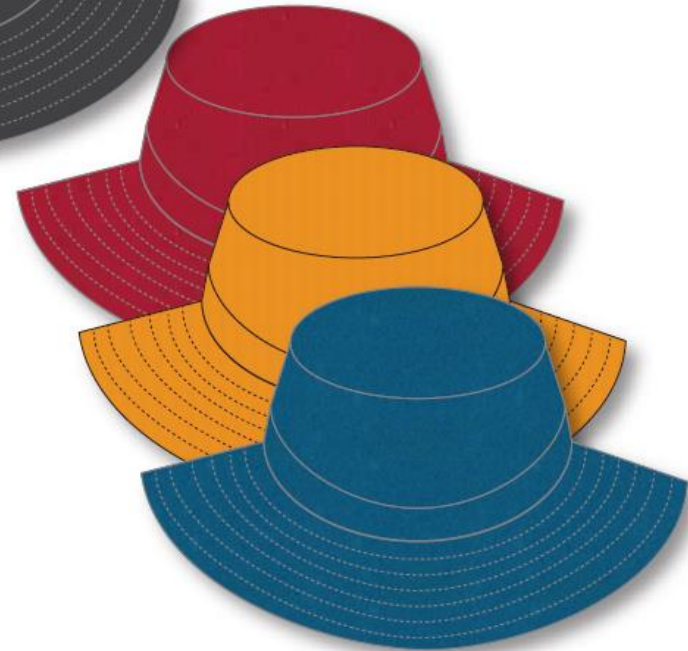
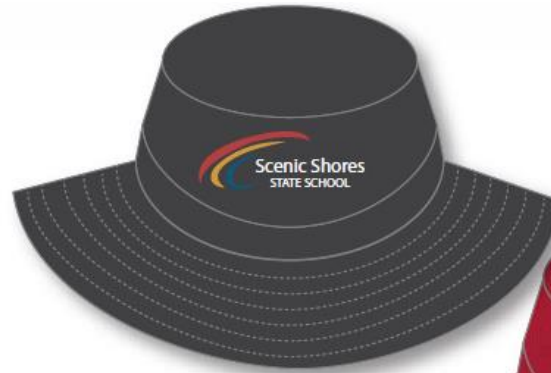
Uniform Management Services (UMS)

Student Resource Scheme
