Library Donations

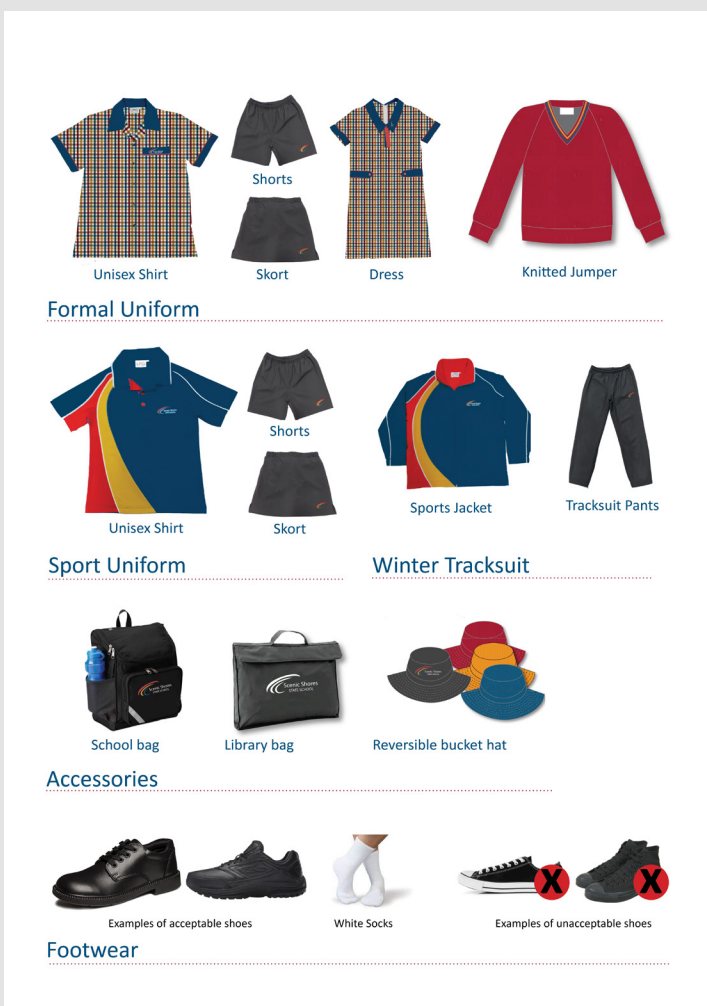

QParents Update

At Scenic Shores State School we are focused on reducing our environmental print and limiting the use of paper. QParents allows parents to access to forms digitally, such as our consent forms. Parents who have completed an Enrolment Application and provided correct identification would now have an active QParents account.

What is QParents?

QParents is an online portal that is free for Queensland state schools to use, and allows parents to view attendance details, behaviour information, report cards, timetables, invoices and a history of payments provide digital consent, reasons for unexplained absences and to notify the school of future absences view and pay school invoices online update student details including residential and postal address as well as medical conditions.
